Economic Development

--- Internet Bill of Rights (IBOR) ---



The Internet Bill of Rights is a set of guidelines that is designed to protect the rights of common citizens on the internet. It is a set of principles that will ensure privacy and security for all people, no matter where they are in the world.

IBOR has been created as an international agreement between governments and other stakeholders, with the goal to prevent any future abuses from occurring. With the proliferation of AI, the need for an internet bill of rights becomes more and more apparent.

IBOR should include provisions that protect data privacy, data ownership, and net neutrality. It should also include provisions that protect users from targeted advertising and content manipulation.

As a Federal Internet Technology Manager, I understand the administrative process that would be required to reposition the United States to lead the IBOR effort. This would require leadership and coordination at multiple levels, including policy, international coordination, technology development, resource allocation and the actual rolling out of the new infrastructure. The effort will require a commitment in terms of funding to establish the United States as a leader in Internet governance.

The United States must take the lead to advance the adoption of IBOR. The benefits of adopting and providing leadership in this area will be felt on a global level by all countries. In order to establish a global framework, the United States must lead by example and be the first country to implement IBOR.

This would give all citizens the power to download their personal data, know who has it, and why it is being used. In return, they could establish a norm where they would receive royalties from companies and entities that use their personal data, including government institutions.



--- Inflation Reduction---

Inflation is an economic condition where the cost of goods and services are rising. This is often caused by the increase in the money supply. When people are buying products, they are bidding up the price because they know that they can charge more tomorrow than they could today. Inflation also leads to a decrease in demand as people buy less because prices keep going up.

A parallel economy can solve this problem by providing more opportunities for people to earn and spend money. This will allow people to buy more goods and services without causing inflation rates to rise. People around the world use barter economies, which can help reduce capital pressure on society. In addition, more and more people are using cryptocurrency, and the trend is set to continue.



I am an AI coder and technologist who has built cryptocurrency contracts and developed businesses built on Web 3 technology. The future of AI is here, which is why I have transitioned to Web 3 development. I will implement a fundamental shift in Governmental contracting and speed up ways people get paid. In addition, I will implement a policy that limits blockchain development without a chain of custody.

The United States is in the midst of a major economic shift. Technology has become increasingly important and people are turning to it for a variety of needs, such as providing customer service or even completing simple day-to-day tasks like grocery shopping. As the trend continues, economists believe that service-based industries will become more popular as we move into this new era. I can help Americans close the gap in learning new methods of transactions, as well as old methods of barter systems in a technological world.



--- Housing and Job Growth ---

Housing is one of the most important aspects of local businesses. The market has an impact on the economy, employment, and quality of life. Single family homes and incentives for renovation & restoration can help revitalize town communities and so much more.

Rebuilding the core of America's suburban towns will revitalize local communities and drive small and medium businesses across main-street America. Coupled with parallel structures, this would be the beginning of a long term revitalization of America. As an infrastructure and base developer for the US Air Force, I have experience in housing and community development. Now that the White House will get access to powerful AI tools, it will be easy to make this happen within a short amount of time.








--- Energy Security ---






--- Business Development ---

The recent pandemic changed the dynamics of the entrepreneur market, making it a difficult time for smaller businesses. Mega corporations who had large cash reserves were able to grab the advantage and expand their market share. The competition is too stiff for main street, and their profit margins are too small. The lesson learned is that the small business community needs to look beyond the conventional, and think "outside-the-box." The way forward for small businesses is through niche markets.



Small businesses can't compete with big corporations as they have a larger customer base; but, niche markets such as hemp provide opportunities for start-ups. There are tons of possibilities when it comes to less common products such as hemp.

There are hemp-based food companies that can now take advantage of the availability of their products because of the legal status of cannabis. Education Reform

--- Charter and Co-Op Homeschool ---

"The Executive Branch could accommodate parents and students who choose alternative learning options through children's access to public school choice programs. The federal government could also provide supplementary funding to help children who are opting out of traditional schools by compensating states through Education Block Grants for per-pupil funds that are lost with that child's departure." ~ Eric Jon Boerner



It's hard to deny that school choice is a very important issue in America right now. Parents and students deserve as many great opportunities as possible when it comes to education. There are many students with limited options at their schools. They often attend a school that is not working for them and it is hard to come out of that cycle. Education is such a vital part of life. The problem of inequity means that too many people - including students - don't get the skills they deserve, and this not only affects them, but also the whole society.


With more freedom in schools, we will be able to give children the opportunity to thrive in learning settings that best meet their needs and the needs of their parents and guardians. But, if we want school choice to become a reality in America, we must be able to provide the funding needed for students to excel. Choice is not free, and Americans are forced to pay more and more every year in higher taxes with less and less return. This makes it hard for many families struggling with financial hardships or who do not have the privilege of going into their own bank accounts to find additional resources.

Many Americans are unaware that the U.S has reached the point where "the wealthiest 1 percent of all Americans now own more wealth than the bottom 90 percent, which is a reversal from just three decades ago." The fortunate few are able to use this wealth as leverage to gain power in the education system, where they eventually become part of a hierarchy and not a democracy. Those institutions of higher learning cater to that 1%, thereby controlling the output of student ideology in Economic-Social norms. Inequality can be prevented if we stepped back and looked at the root cause of failing students. Is it the school, is it the curriculum, or is it the methods?



As a father of a Charter School child. I know that there are tremendous differences between a public school and a school of choice. More than 50% of my daughter's school graduated with honors, went into running-start, or began college courses as they went into High School. This was because the methodologies presented were levels ahead of traditional public schooling. Sadly, for the rest of Washington, her Charter School is the only one of its kind in North Seattle. The selection process is done by lottery and is extremely competitive. Parents in WA State want this kind of education system. Her fortunate luck of attending a school of choice is the main reason why she is enrolled at a good University.

As President, I would collaborate with local and state education experts to figure out how to tackle educational problems. I'm in favor of everyone having the opportunity for their children to attend a different school. I will allocate funds to help pay tuition for families who want to take advantage of these new options. I will also instruct the




Department of Education to develop ways to identify teachers and students who excel in scholastic pursuits, and reward them with grants to help them continue their education. One of the other challenges facing American education today is the high rate of students dropping out of school. As President, I will work closely with state and local officials to identify students who are struggling at school and get them into the program that is best for them.



--- Trade School Grants ---

Skilled workers are in high demand which means we need to encourage more people to enter skilled work. This can be done by encouraging recipients of federal aid to study in trade school first before they enroll into an area of study. If they study, they will be more likely to stay in their field because trade school provides a constant career path and better wages, as well as the opportunity for advancement.

People in skilled work are more likely to have good earnings, which means they will help the economy. Skilled occupations in the trades like electricians, plumbers, carpenters, and millwrights are being taken advantage of by lower-skilled workers from overseas. This creates a system of low quality products, which are very expensive. Skilled workers who have good jobs that pay well have the ability to spend their earnings and help drive the economy.



Increased immigration will also help to fill in these skills gaps short term. To tailor the needs of the US and its companies, the US has to push for immigration reform that encourages talented people to come in and give them a chance to work in areas that US companies lack. However, a trade school program would also help Americans fill gaps in skills and thus help create a more productive economy at home.

The United States needs more skilled people to fill in labor shortages if it wants to grow and be economically prosperous. Immigration of highly-skilled individuals will help make up for the workforce that is lacking in those positions. It is

important that local jobs are available to US citizens, and while there are currently adequate trade school programs in the US, a grant system would be beneficial.



--- Volunteer Service Development ---

The Peace Corps is an organization that provides young people with the opportunity to make a difference in the world by sharing their skills and love of country. In addition to providing communities with essential knowledge and skills, volunteers also have the opportunity to learn new things around the world. As president, I will implement a National Community Development Program that will work with domestic communities and provide affordable access to quality housing, employment opportunities, and safety.

One major focus of this strategy will be to advocate for strengthening neighborhoods through volunteer programs within the Peace



Corps. We should push for community initiatives that will be in line with my administration's goal of a more empowered and engaged populace. Initiatives that will be in line with HUD's mission which is "to create strong, sustainable, inclusive communities and quality affordable homes for all."

As a community developer and planner, I have extensive experience in developing policy to allow our Administration to start this project immediately. This would bring much-needed jobs and economic development to areas of the country that have been in need for many years. I want to ensure that government agencies operate efficiently, are well-funded, and work with the best outcomes. By taking these steps early in my presidency, we will be able to strengthen America for years to come.

The federal government's housing policy has a serious impact on the community. It can help to create more affordable housing options for those who need it. By volunteering and creating programming for low-income households, we can help achieve these goals. The Peace Corps program can help revitalize communities through NCDP training programs.

The number of veterans who volunteer their time to communities has also grown in recent years. This is a trend that has been steadily increasing with the introduction of veteran transition programs. These programs help veterans find jobs and adjust to civilian life. As President I would ensure these programs also dovetail with NCDP program grants.



--- Meritorious Grants for Higher Education ---

Some companies try to hire US citizens to lead certain projects, while others send their company leaders to America's top schools.

US citizens should be given the opportunity to develop their aptitude early on. This way it can lead to a higher level of education opportunities. This could lead to the development of a new program for Executive Management that would give the federal government an ample pool of highly qualified candidates, by using AI selection methods. The sources of development in this area should come from the American public and not just US institutions.



If elected President I would create a grant program that invests in institutions of higher education which accept the most talented students from the program. These students will be recognized as some of the best in their field, while excelling in the tough academic requirements for entry.

We can provide new pathways to employment in a changing workforce with this grant program. With my administration's initiatives in offering just-in-time supply chains and nimble high tech industry, the programs would ensure an adaptable workforce. There is also a need for qualified high tech industry executive managers that can work with the new technologies and policy governing those advances.




--- Armed Services College Grants ---

More and more military personnel are using the GI Bill program to transition to college. They not only gain from the opportunity that this offers, but also increase their skills as future leaders in the US economy. One of the goals of this bill is to help veterans find a career they will enjoy. It has been shown to be good for both the veteran and the entire country because it provides effective leadership in work spaces.

I'm a Veteran myself, and I have taken advantage of the GI Bill program and other programs designed to help Veterans. As President, I will make sure Veterans have better access to their GI Bill benefits so they can use it on things like trade schools and STEM programs.

As President of the United States, I will ensure that our veterans have all the support they need to further their education and careers. From trade school to an Ivy League education, I will



provide the necessary resources for an individualized education plan. I will reset the bar and ensure that priority support goes to all heroes, not just the recent ones coming home.

Support for our veterans is essential for the creation of a strong country with a strong uniformed service. I will work tirelessly to ensure no veteran faces education disparity, homelessness or unemployment. We will work to ensure that the VA provides all veterans with access to quality care and attention to transitioning to civilian life.



--- Agriculture and Food Education ---



The USDA plays an important role in regulating our food supply. With scientific advances in technology and changes in how we think about our food, it's important that USDA inspectors are able to focus on the farms and meet them on their level. Whether it is a small, family-run farm or a large-scale operation, there are strict guidelines that must be followed to ensure the safety of the produce and meat we eat.

As president, I will make sure there are programs in place to help future veterinarians work with the USDA. One of the reasons we need more livestock vets in

this country is because the agriculture industry has become increasingly complex. More qualified USDA vets ensures the food supply is safe and gives access to future educational opportunities to younger generations.

I've done a lot of community planning in the past. I also have experience with building communities during a societal collapse. My focus will be on rebuilding business sectors and creating strong infrastructures that last. In many urban areas, revitalization projects could allow fresh food brands to break into cities and change how people think about what is available.

Projects that get USDA backing would also make it easier for people to access fresher food. We need to be more thoughtful about how we manage our resource and supply methods. We could work with city departments to help them create food forests that would not only be grown locally, but would also bring a sense of pride to their community.



National Security

--- Border Security ---

There are a number of factors that affect the flow of migrants coming into the U.S. One such factor is trade between our country and the countries outside of it. The United States could increase trade with Mexico, South America, and Africa, for example, in order to reduce migration. The US can reap the benefits of stabilizing other countries by trading with them and thereby keeping its trade surplus going. It can also increase security in the region by building alliances, especially our closest neighbors. Mexico's main source of imports comes from the U.S. The U.S.'s engagement with Mexico can be strengthened and this will help increase their



imports, while also supporting their strategic economic interests in North America.

The US can also support these countries in other ways such as providing humanitarian aid or providing food security. Another factor that affects the flow of migrants coming into the U.S. is the level of unemployment and political instability in various countries outside of its borders. The lack of economic opportunities, lack of law, and domestic violence are all reasons people will want to migrate to the United States. The US could reduce migration by focusing on economic development in these regions, working with governments to find fair trade alliances and new supply chains that could allow for more jobs and opportunity.

In the meantime, the US needs to start a campaign similar to that of refugee camps. They need to provide immediate care for these migrants and set them up with all they will need in order to start their new lives, just like refugees do. I was instrumental in building refugee camps during Desert Storm for the Kurdish refugees. I also have experience in dealing with crises such as the migrant crisis at our borders. There are people fleeing their homes in search of a better life and the US is often generous with those searching for that better life.

In addition to the idea of providing temporary camps for migrants to wait out the storm, I feel that a lot of these migrants could be provided with good jobs and better job opportunities. The US needs to invest more in construction and manufacturing. This would provide more opportunities for these people who are trying to make their way in this country.



--- Homelessness ---

They say one thing leads to another. There are many theories about why people become homeless, but most agree that homelessness is a complex problem with no single cause. Many believe that addiction is the root of the problem. With repeated exposure, those struggling with addiction who are homeless, often wish to remain homeless.



The best way to solve this problem is with patience and education. People who are addicted often feel ashamed and humiliated, so it's important that their privacy be protected. This is why there needs to be a focus on providing resources and sheltered communities to recover in. Creating sheltered communities in border states could also address some of the migration issues on our borders.

As US President, I will use my experience from Desert Storm to develop border community plans with the Corp of Engineers, State National Guards, and the State Governors that seek help with migrant influx. Through community development and recovery empowerment, we can solve both the homelessness crisis and migrant crisis in each state with a well-structured homelessness plan and immigration policy mechanism.

Through recovery and shelter programs, it is possible to shift the homelessness problem into an economic benefit for the nation. My administration will fix the migration issue and address homelessness at the same time. The lessons learned in community building and development can be used to build upon for each state who is facing an influx. Taking on the task now ensures stronger border security and economic growth in those areas of the nation.

Considering the large number of homeless people in America, we should think of them as refugees as well. The US military set up base camps in Iraq and Turkey that flourished over time and became full-fledged towns. I was a part of that effort before and will develop plans to bring that level of attention to both the migrant and homeless crises if elected.




--- Drug Crisis ----

Heroine, Methamphetamine, Cocaine, and "Crocodile" are major problems in America. It is important to note though that the prescription opioid addiction that has become prevalent in recent years is also a major problem. Overprescribing these drugs to treat chronic pain has caused a large uptick in patients with dependency issues.

I too have a long history of chronic pain, after many injuries and complicated surgeries. I know how difficult it is to break the pain cycle each time. Throughout a holistic program and medical cannabis, I was able to recover from the harmful side-effects of both opioids and gabapentin.

We need to take control of the illegal drug situation AND end the root cause of addiction. The pharma dynasty in health care is that root cause. My administration will promote a hybrid health system that utilizes holistic care approaches with proven medical practices. Americans must have their medical rights respected with proven and informed consent before getting medical advice from practitioners.



As your President, I pledge to take action to ensure that medical practitioners are not influenced or pushed by the pharmaceutical industry to prescribe drugs for uses not approved by the FDA. I will instruct the FDA to research and provide policy guidelines for medical cannabis use, while also enacting stricter laws that locate the illegal drug manufacturing rings plaguing the American population.

When I was a member of a federal task force to identify the most likely locations of methamphetamine cook houses in the Mojave Desert, I had access to data that isn't available to most citizens. It helped me identify potential dangers and risks for Federal Law Enforcement quicker than usual. The issue of drugs in America is a big problem and many people don't know the full depth of the crisis. By approaching it with compassion and strength, we can help many Americans recover their lives and get into society again.



--- Immigration Reform ---

The United States' immigration policy allows ample opportunities for people to come and work legally. However, the application process can be rigorous, with lengthy waiting periods and a high rejection rate. I would like to see an administrative review of the application process in order to eliminate red tape, shorten wait times, and more accurately vet applicants before issuing visas. I would support a fast track program that provides high caliber applicants easier access, while enforcing stricter background checks for those seeking employment in high technology industries. This would help the American economy and create more opportunities for everyone.

I would also like to see a review of the United States' visa policy to ensure that we are leveling the playing field for Americans who wish to remain in this country. In addition, I support an increase in standardized entry requirements for all countries seeking visas into the U.S., in order to create greater transparency and prevent additional, unnecessary bureaucracy from weighing down our immigration process. I support suspending immigration from countries that are unable to adequately vet their citizens. I think it would be very important in order to prevent any potential threats from entering our borders.

Given the significant role the border patrol plays in maintaining a secure and efficient country, we should make sure to have adequate security measures. This includes making sure everyone visiting our country is properly vetted to ensure they are not at risk of any harm and not delaying or cutting into our immigration process. When we think about terrorism, it is important to be cautious but proactive in order to prevent future instances. It is critical that we closely work with law enforcement agencies by sharing information and also ensuring a strong presence of Interpol data sharing with U.S. law enforcement, especially as they combat international organized networks.

As President, I would create a diplomatic corps that is skilled in trade, human rights, and technology development. American workers and employers alike are in favor of the Visa program at our embassies. The US State Department will provide great opportunities for entrepreneurs to start their business in other countries, while also supporting foreign companies who want to expand into the US. The Visa processing will be done quickly and safely, while increasing job opportunities in the US. The USA is a powerhouse in the world that can provide unique skills worldwide, and it only makes sense for us to serve as an example of what's possible.



--- Armed Services and Veteran Care ---

As AI is more and more integrated into military systems, military organizations across the world are changing how they approach wars. Privatized AI technology has changed our battlefield and the way we conduct war in cyberspace and the real world domains.


As both coder and simulation expert, I understand how drastically we need to shift our military force into new eras of psychological resilience. I will make sure that our military units are trained and well equipped for whatever future peril we may be fighting. Whether that peril is human, digital, or a force of AI controlled robots.

I have seen the effects of war and combat

on our service members when they come home. I understand why veterans' struggles with mental health are often overlooked, but this needs to change. Feeling safe is one of the main needs of service members returning from deployment. With operations on the rise, our Veterans will need a greater focus on mental health care in the near future.

My Administration would be focused on the intersection of psychological combat-stress and PTSD. We need to make sure that combat programs have the proper support structures in place for veterans of war. They are at a higher risk for developing other, often more debilitating, physical conditions such as cardiovascular disease.





--- Foreign Diplomacy ---

The United States, as the world's superpower, has always been involved in international



affairs. The country is best served when using diplomacy to solve problems instead of resorting to violence. It has been able to increase engagement in many parts of the world through it's diplomatic corps.

It is important that the United States maintain a strong military force, but it must be guided by diplomacy as well. We must also be mindful of how much we spend on defense and not let it get in the way of diplomatic engagement. Military force has played a key role in making major decisions for the US in history. However, I believe diplomacy will play an important part too and provide stability going forward.

I have been mentored by a senior diplomat over the past ten years and know that diplomacy is always more effective than military force. During my time in the US Air Force, I was involved in many hearts and minds programs for the Department of Defense. I will use my experience in

negotiating with dignitaries when speaking to leaders of other nations to pursue America's goals of peace and prosperity for all.

We are the best country in the world when it comes to reaching out diplomatically to other nations. The US is on a constant path of success and is a great example of how being respectful, proud and dignified can change lives for the better. Under my Administration, we will continue that tradition of good statesmanship through diplomatic avenues.



Government Regulation

--- Crime and Justice ---

It's clear that we need a better way of resolving public discourse and dealing with society's challenges. Our law system should strive to be more fair, balanced and in touch with today's world. It is necessary that our Federal Law offices are reformed accordingly. The Federal Law Office has had problems with management and politicization. These have caused issues like turn-over and morale. We do not have enough qualified inspectors which results in worse service for our country.

As a former member of the Office of the Inspector General, I have experience in creating policy and determining when administrative law has been broken. I will make sure that each of the Federal communities examines their policies to ensure no violation of administrative law or ethics takes place. I promise that I will disrupt any networks within Federal communities that have a political bias in their daily service to the public.



In recent years, there has been a major uptick in crime rates. Police departments are struggling to fill their positions with qualified candidates. I will work to strengthen law enforcement tools both on a state and federal level so that hiring and firing methods can be made more effective.

As President, I will work to expand access to crime-fighting technologies that are currently being used in only a few cities, like body cameras and predictive policing technology. More trust between law enforcement and civilians would have a ripple effect that would help the community overall. Law enforcement would be more respected which means people would be more likely to cooperate with officers in need of assistance.

Mass incarceration is an important issue that affects our entire society. Focusing on outcome-based systems will be a challenge, but I am committed to finding solutions that address the issue. We'll work with law enforcement in urban areas across the country to stop any abuse of power. This way, leaders in those communities can focus on cultural expression of diversity and those areas can be a safe place for everyone.



--- Technology and Cybercrime ---

Cybercrime is at an all-time high. Criminals are finding new and different ways to steal and extort money from people they target, by hacking their email accounts, phones and home security systems. In some cases, recent events show that the art of social engineering online can lead to extraordinary thefts.

In addition to this, the Office of Personnel Management and other Federal offices have been subjected to a number of cyber-attacks over the years. This includes one of the most significant attacks on US Government officials in decades. It's important to take steps to protect this vital asset to national security with current and emerging technologies.



One of the most innately compelling use cases for IBOR is cybersecurity. The United States would be better protected from cyberattacks if it starts using IBOR protocols. The implementation of the IBOR protocol and web3 will create new opportunities for decentralization in cybersecurity.

I've been instrumental in building Big Data architecture in US Government and Businesses, as well as being one of the founding coders of blockchain methodologies. I have the skills and experience to bring both an understanding of policy and the technical know-how in order to implement IBOR while strengthening our Cyber Infrastructure if elected President.



--- Social Security and Healthcare ---

We need to end the era of medical experimentation without consent. Governments responded to this global pandemic in a reactive manner that was not just unnecessary, but dangerously unethical and immoral. Governments cannot be allowed to apply irrelevant medical interventions on children and adults without their consent, under the pretext of saving the lives of others.

The human cost of rushed, emergency drug approvals, and off-label use, is too high. I pledge as your president to ban unethical medical practices on US citizens. As a consumer, you deserve the right to know what's in the drugs you're taking, and international pharmaceutical corporations should not be allowed to push drugs for emergency use without fully understanding all risks and



side-effects. If necessary, I will issue an executive order reinforcing the FDA approval process.

While the Affordable Care Act has helped to reduce insurance costs for many Americans, it has done little to address the skyrocketing costs of hospitalization. With an increase in the number of insured patients, hospitalization rates and costs have also increased. The U.S. should implement a Medicare & VA hospital reform effort that reduces the cost of hospitalizations and makes it easier for medical professionals to do their jobs.

Lastly, Social Security is in danger. The trust fund that backs the system will be tapped out and it will not be able to pay benefits in full. The most important thing we can do to fix this is to make sure all Americans have a secure retirement through Social Security. We have the right people to optimize government IT systems and fund management software within my Administration. With my Governmental Overhaul Act, SSA will become a streamlined office in order to reduce the pressure on the trust fund.



--- US Federal Budget and Congress ---



When I am President, I will hold Congress accountable for the budget and make sure that they give the agencies what they need. The federal government spends approximately \$3 trillion a year but our representatives in Congress don't seem to care what it's spent on. They don't ask questions about where the money goes and how it's being spent which is unacceptable. Once I am elected, I will work hard to bring better accountability to the table.

We need to make government work better for We The People. Congress should not make promises they don't keep or put off passing budgets at the end of the fiscal year. Cooperation is key for parties of different ideologies. If we don't hold Congress accountable, they will most likely keep

taking advantage of this political game, which will eventually lead to an economic downfall.

Pushing the budget too late in the year, or implementing a Continuing Resolution, forces the president's office to implement Executive Orders. This is seen as a partisan bypass of spending laws. Congress must finalize the budget on time to prevent Executive Branch Overreach.

When Congress has enough time to approve a spending budget, it gives more time for input and avoids a government shutdown. As a federal manager, I have experience in budgeting for line offices and ensuring that my staff have the resources they need to operate at all times. I've designed and implemented organizational policies that made sure agencies stayed productive, while lowering operational costs. I will hold Congress to the same standard that all employees in Government must adhere too, including being on time with their budget.



--- Finance and Taxes ---

America needs to diversify its investments and change its tax code in order to make the US economy less centralized. The economy is reliant on consumer-driven spending and this lends it more susceptibility to new technology or economic shocks than other countries with a more diversified economy. We need a new tax reform to rescue the US from our financial crisis.

My Tax Reform Act will be a huge opportunity for the American people. It will not only lower tax rates, but also simplify the entire process. The initiative will provide relief to small businesses and level the playing field for all citizens. Advances in technology have made it possible to reduce the burden on employers and taxpayers by simplifying reporting processes. The IRS will implement a new and improved system that will streamline the process.

I am dedicated to ending tax shelters for large, offshore companies that bring no economic gain to US taxpayers. The US government is spending billions of dollars every year to




subsidize these large offshore companies that bring no economic gain to US taxpayers. Corporations should be required to pay their fair share of federal, state and local taxes.

With the changes in the corporate tax codes, small business tax reductions, and simplifying tax codes, IRS tax audits and enforcement could be eliminated. In addition, the Federal Election Commission should enact administrative policy that sets a unified voting system for all states. This would make state elections more closely resemble national elections and increase voter turnout.

The disparate voting laws make it difficult for national candidates to campaign across state lines. This has given mainstream media, and social media outlets a monopoly on a candidate's ability to campaign effectively. Unifying voting laws across states also ensures constituents have access to varied political voices around the country during America's technological era.

By simplifying voting laws and enacting a uniform national standard for voter access, reports of election fraud should diminish. This would restore confidence in US elections, increase voter turnout, and make America's electoral process easier to understand.
